

**PARENTAL NOTIFICATION**  
**RIGHTS OF A CHILD WHO BECOMES**  
**A VICTIM OF A VIOLENT CRIME**

Should a child fall victim of a violent crime at school, he or she will have the right to transfer to another school within the local school district.

A student shall be considered the victim of a violent crime at school when evidence is found to reasonably indicate that the student was the victim of the applicable offenses cited in TCA 40-38-111 or the attempt to commit one of these offenses as defined under TCA 30-12-101 and the offense occurred while the student was attending school or traveling to or from school on the school bus.

**The crime must be determined by law enforcement to meet the criteria according to TCA-40-38-111 or TCA 30-12-101.**
